Instructions to Owners/Exhibitors:

1. Complete Part 1 of this form.
2. This form is not an interstate entry permit. However, if stock are likely to be sold or moved onwards from a show, Part 2 should be completed by your local animal health official to assist authorities prepare the necessary official interstate movement certificates.
3. This form provides the basis for preparing documentation required by other states prior to entry of cattle. Further testing and disease certification may be required for cattle entering some states.
4. There is no provision for individual animal testing for Johne's Disease (JD) on this form.
5. This Herd Health Status form is valid for 6 months from the date of issue. The owner must notify the issuing local animal health official of any change in herd status or other information on the form subsequent to completion of this form.

# JOHNES DISEASE REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to enter the National Simmental Show and Sale, all animals must be Johnes Disease MAP accredited (MN1, MN2 or MN3) or Check Tested or originate from a Johnes Free Zone or Johnes Protected Zone.

Additional special BEEF ONLY requirements apply. Contact the local Veterinary Officer for details. A Vendor Declaration Form for such herds can be obtained from the Simmental Australia office.

Vendors in the Control and Residual Zones with Non Assessed cattle are therefore advised to consider having their herds MAP accredited or Check Tested well before the sale to gain entry to the sale and to broaden potential market destinations post sale.

The following advice on Johnes Disease requirements for entry to Wodonga Sale Complex and movement restrictions post sale, was supplied by Mr Jeff Cave, District Veterinary Officer, Wodonga.

“To be eligible to enter the Protected Zone, cattle from the Control Zone need to be Check Tested or MAP accredited, and cattle from the Residual Zone need to be MAP accredited. Beef only cattle may enter Protected Zones except for QLD and NT.

To enter the Free Zone (WA), cattle from the Protected Zone need to be MN1, MN2 or MN3, while cattle from the Control or Residual Zones must be MN2 or MN3 status. (subject to audit for MN2 status).”

The following table outlines the BJD requirements for movement into different zones.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Southern Simmental Sale will be conducted by the Southern Simmental Sale Committee under the auspices of ASBA NSW Branch engaging Elders and Landmark as agents.

Entries will be accepted from members of the Australian Simmental Breeders Association Limited and the following conditions will be strictly adhered to:

1. Entries will be open to the following:
  - (a) Led and unled Purebred Bulls born between **01.09.2006 and 01.05.2008.**
  - (b) Led and unled Purebred Females born before **01.05.2008.**
  - (c) Led and unled bulls with a minimum of 50% Simmental content born between **01.09.2006 and 01.05.2008.**
  - (d) Led or unled females with a minimum of 50% Simmental content born before **01.05.2008.**
  - (e) Led or unled calves (by ET) under 12 months of age at sale date. If under seven months of age calves must be with their recipient dams.
2. All cattle must be registered or recorded with the A.S.B.A. prior to entering and in the case of young calves - prior to the day of sale. All vendors must be financial members of ASBA with herd inventory fees fully paid.  
**Breedplan figures will be published for all eligible cattle entered in the sale.**
3. A lot shall comprise from one (1) to ten (10) animals.
4. **PARADE GROUPS:**
  - (a) All animals entered must be paraded in their respective age groups.  
The breakdown of these groups will be done on receipt of entries.
5. **GENERAL:**

All led animals must have the following:

  - 1) Appropriate nose rings or clips.
  - 2) Adequate halters and neck straps to be used at all times where animals are left unattended.
  - 3) Suitable delivery halters must be provided; if not, the agent will provide and charge vendor's accounts.
6. **SALE ORDER:**
  1. LED FEMALES
  2. LED BULLS
  3. UNLED BULLS
  4. UNLED FEMALES

Each section to be sold in age order.
7. Entry forms must be completed in full and signed by the vendor.  
**THE ORIGINAL REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE MUST BE ATTACHED TO THE ENTRY FORM for ANIMAL LOTS.**
8. **INSPECTION**
  - a) INSPECTION will commence at 9.00am on Monday, May 4, 2009, at Wodonga Stud Selling Complex by official A.S.B.A. appointed inspectors. All cattle must be ready for inspection by 8.00am on Monday, May 4, 2009. Vendors should particularly note regulations relating to tattooing, dehorning, temperament and general conformation and condition.
  - b) The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry.
  - c) Cattle rejected by inspectors are to be moved to an approved area of the showgrounds, away from sale cattle, AS SOON AS POSSIBLE after inspection. These cattle are not available for the auction sale. No entry fee will be refunded on these cattle.
9. S1 Recording Forms and/or Registration Certificates must be available prior to tattoo inspection for calves at foot.
10. All entry fees must be paid at the time of entering and will cover advertising, internet cataloguing and yard dues.  
**ENTRY FEE \$275.00 per lot for Purebreds, \$130 per lot for other cattle,** (includes Transfer Fee and GST) per Lot.
  - a) No refunds will be provided on lots withdrawn, other than in exceptional circumstances. (ie: animal death).
  - b) Substitution of an entry, by the same vendor, will be considered by the Committee on receipt of written request.
11. **Entries close Friday, March 6, 2009 with:**  
Simmental Australia, ABRI, UNE ARMIDALE, NSW 2351  
**NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**  
**Cheques made payable to Southern Simmental Sale Committee.**
12. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:**
  - a) All cattle must be derived from a Confirmed Free or Accredited Free Brucellosis herd.
  - b) All cattle entered must have NLIS tags attached.
  - c) All cattle attending the sale must be accompanied by a completed Cattle Herd Health Status Form, available from the Duty Agent and copy attached.  
A National Vendor Declaration Form is to be presented when stock are delivered to the Sale Complex.
  - d) All stock entered for sale must comply with requirements relating to Johnes Disease. Cattle must be from a herd that is MAP accredited or Check Tested or from a non assessed property in the Free or Protected Zones. See attached article on Johnes Disease requirements for cattle movement.

13. All females are sold as guaranteed breeders.
- a) Females over two (2) years are sold P.T.I.C. or with a calf at foot fulfilling the breeding guarantee. In addition, if the calf is over six (6) months-of-age, the lot entered is rejoined and P.T.I.C. with the veterinarian's P.T.I.C. certificate submitted by close of entries.
  - b) Where the purchaser submits a veterinary report to a vendor that an unjoined heifer cannot be got in calf within twelve (12) months of the date of sale, the vendor is liable to refund the purchase price in full, less selling costs, (Clause 19) to the buyer. These conditions do not apply where a female is entered into an embryo transplant programme.
14. Vendors must stipulate on the entry form if a female has been embryo transplanted. If this is the case, she must have a calf at foot or be P.T.I.C. If the calf is over (6) six months of age, the lot entered is rejoined and P.T.I.C. with the veterinarian's P.T.I.C. certificate submitted by close of entries.
15. The vendor of any cattle catalogued "Pregnancy Tested In Calf" must supply a veterinary certificate to this effect. This certificate must be handed to the Duty Agent on the day prior to sale, (Inspection Day). If the calf is over (6) six months of age, the veterinarian's P.T.I.C. certificate is to be submitted by close of entries.
16. Vendors must stipulate on the entry form if the entry is a result of natural birth or E.T.
17. Bulls are to be sold as fertile and capable of natural service. The purchaser shall have the right of cancelling the sale of a bull within six (6) months of the date of sale if he can submit a veterinary report to the effect that the bull is infertile or incapable of natural service. The veterinary surgeon must state that in his/her own opinion, the bull has not suffered any injury which could have affected his breeding ability since being taken delivery of by the purchaser. The vendor is liable to refund the purchase price in full, less selling costs (Clause 18) to the buyer.
18. Selling costs to the vendor will include:  
 Agents Commission  
 Rebate Levy - 1.5%.  
 A.S.B.A. Transfer Fees - All sold lots will be transferred to purchasers. To facilitate prompt transfers to eligible purchasers, the vendor's signature on the Sale Entry Form serves as an irrevocable authority for ASBA to transfer the registration following the sale. Where the transfer is to an ASBA stud member, the 2% Transfer Levy plus GST will be debited to the vendor's Association account. In the event of a non-sale, the transfer fee and the transfer levy plus GST will be refunded.
19. The sale catalogue will be placed on the ASBA Website's Sale Cataloguing Service. Vendors may submit a good quality photograph of each sale animal for inclusion at no extra cost. Photographs to be submitted to the ASBA office no later than **06.03.09**
20. The inclusion of a photograph of a sale animal in the printed catalogue is \$110. This amount must be included with your entry fee, including copy of photograph. Other advertising space is available in the printed catalogue.
