

Victorian Female Spring Sale Report

The Victorian Female Spring Sale held at the Whittlesea sale complex on 16th, November, resulted in 14 of the 32 females on offer being sold. Top price of \$3500 was for Trijena Duchess D014, a 15mth heifer by Bar 5P SA Evolution, offered by the Rizzo family, going to commercial breeders LD & WA Fairbairn from Kingaroy, QLD. The Fairbairns also purchased the other Trijena offering, Trijena Donna for \$2400. Another commercial buyer Noel Harvey from Nagambie, who has been a regular buyer at the spring sale, purchased 4 females with local breeders I & J Johnson, Glenhaven Simmentals buying 3.

Victorian president, Peter Wenn thanked the vendors, some coming from as far as South Australia for the excellent quality of cattle presented. Peter said that although buyer numbers were down on the past few years, the Victorian Branch will continue to promote this sale next year and will also have a Bull sale at the Whittlesea venue on 15th, March 2010.
