

Brewers Simmentals Bull Sale Tops \$5,500

Despite the prevailing extremely dry conditions, a large attendance and a good quality lineup of bulls resulted in a top price of \$5,500 and a healthy \$3,220 average price at the inaugural on-property Brewers Simmental Bull Sale on April 14, 2005.

Willaluka Murray Grey stud, Naracoorte, SA, through Dick Whale, purchased the \$5,500 top priced and equal \$5,000 second top priced bulls, both purebred Black Simmental bulls by GW Lucky Dice 187H.

Duck Island Past Co, SA, through Jan Gray, purchased the equal \$5,000 second top priced bull, a SimAngus bull.

Another SimAngus bull sold for \$3,500 to RH Beers and Sons, Albury. They also bought a Brewers Bandit V190 son for \$2,000.

Don and Betty Rowley, Nero Park Simmentals, Howlong bought Brewers Neff Y397 for \$3,000 and Brewers Tom X361 for \$2,500.

Peter and Kerry Tull, Murrinstone Simmentals, Yea, Vic, paid \$3,000 for Tangara Tyson Y327 offered by M & J Wegener's Tangara Simmentals, Walla Walla, NSW.

Bongongo Angus, Coolac, NSW, purchased two bulls, the \$3,000 Brewers Neff Y395 and the \$2,000 Fulhamgrange Schooly 147 offered by Injemyra Genetics.

TJ & N Boyer, Nagambie purchased Brewers Pascoe X356 for \$2,500.

Other bulls sold for \$2,500.

The sale, conducted in the new sale facility at Brewers Simmentals, is likely to become an annual fixture in the annual Simmental Sale Diary.
